• Vote early in person: Residents may vote early in person by visiting the Auditor-Treasurer's Office in the Government Center, 101 Main Ave. N., Thief River Falls Residents can visit Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. except for holidays. Extended in-person early voting hours will be available between 9 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturday, Nov. 4, and between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on Monday, Nov. 6.

• Vote in person on Election Day: All district residents will cast their vote at a combined polling location on Election Day — the Coodridge Senior Center.
